**Father Patrick writes:** *The Mass times for the weekend of 18/19 September will be different. As the Pope is celebrating Mass at Cofton Park and I will be away, it has been decided that on Sunday 19 September there will be no 10 am Mass here. All those who wish to go to morning Mass are to go to St Austin's at 10.30 am. The Saturday evening 6.00 pm Mass will remain the same. Therefore, if as many of you as possible can come to this Mass it will help.*

*As a result of this change for one week only the sick will not receive Holy Communion.*

*At the back of the church there will be copies of a booklet called Magnificat. This is produced by the publishers of the Catholic Herald three or four times a year. This particular edition has details of the Papal Visit including the liturgy for the masses and reflections.*

*The Bishops Conference of England and Wales has asked for parishes to distribute them to the people this weekend and next, one per family. It is free, however, this is the Catholic Church and a donation of £2 has been suggested.*

*If you wish to continue receiving the Magnificat you can subscribe to it. It is different to Bible Alive.*
